- **Bus:**

In Newcastle gibt es eine "Fair-Free-Zone".  
In diesem Bereich kann man kostenlos mit dem Bus von 7.30am bis 6pm fahren.  
(sehr gut um einkaufen zu gehen!!)

Linie 349 oder 350: grosses Einkaufszentrum:  
"Charlestown"

Linie 225: grosses Einkaufszentrum "Kotara"

Busticket: 3.70\$ (das Ticket gilt für 1 Stunde Busfahrt)

Bus von Newcastle bis zur Uni kostet 3.40\$ und dauert ca. 30 Minuten mit dem schnellsten Bus (Linie 100).



- **Zug:**

Von der Haltestation Newcastle oder Civic kann man einen Zug nach Sydney nehmen (Dauer ca. 2,5-3 h).

Zug von Newcastle oder Civic bis zur Uni (Station "Warabrook") kostet 3.80\$ und dauert ca. 10 Minuten. (Hunter Line!!)



- **Einkaufsmöglichkeiten:**

- Market Town: Supermarkt (Coles), Bäckerei, Thailänder, Fast Food... unter einem Dach.
- Aldi in der Union Street.
- Hunter Mall: (Einkaufsstrasse in der Innenstadt von Newcastle) Fast Food, Restaurants, Klamottenläden, Bäckereien
- Kotara: grosses Einkaufszentrum (ca. 30 Min. von Newcastle mit dem Bus)
- Charlestown: grosses Einkaufszentrum (ca 45. Min von Newcastle mit dem Bus)

*Nobby's Beach*: sehr schön und super um Surfen zu lernen



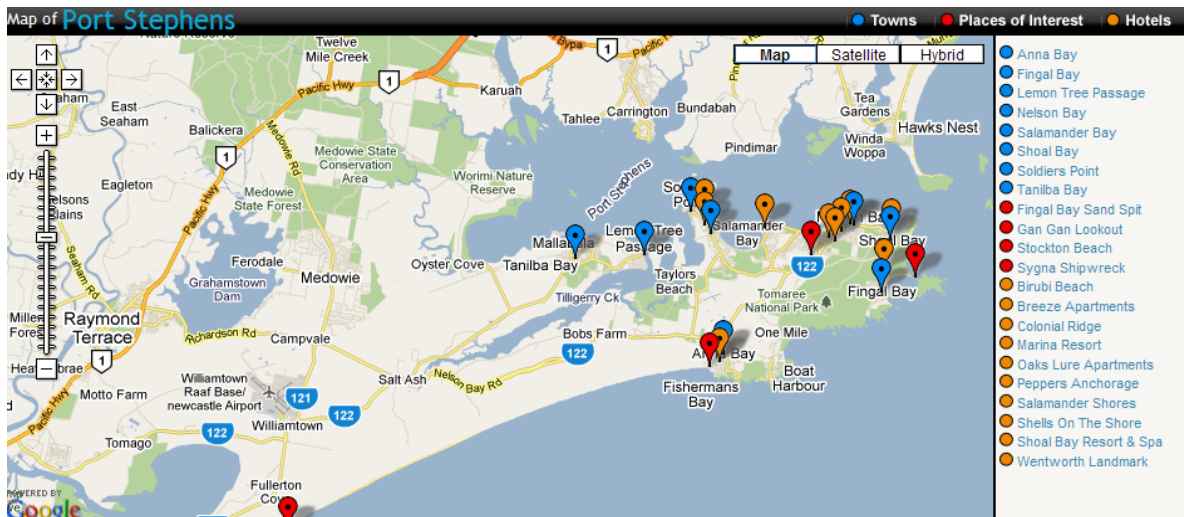
*Newcastle Beach*: sehr schön mit Kiosk

### **Shooping food and stuff:**

At the front gate of the house turn right till Union Street then:

- ➔ turn right for ALDI Store (10-15 min walk)
- ➔ turn left for the Junction fare incl. Coles Supermarket, bottle shop, hairdresser and **Hot Dollar Shop**

The Hot Dollar Shop in the Junction Fare is located vice versa from Coles supermarket and offers heaps of stuff for your daily life. You should have a look inside especially when you just arrived in Newcastle because that shop sells nearly everything (cutlery, plates, pots, fry pans, souvenirs, toiletries)

**SPECIAL:Every Wednesday at the Junction Hotel:  
Schnitzel Night for 10 \$ - I can highly recommend it!**

**Or try “The Junction Chinese Take away” vice versa of the Junction fare.  
For 10 \$ you get beef, chicken or pork with rice  
Open every day except Mondays**

### **Beaches:**

At the Front gate of the house turn left and walk 500m to the Bar beach where you can enjoy breakfast, lunch, dinner or just a coffee with seaside view.

- ➔ Tip: Try the fries or the prawn baguette there – YUMMI

Or walk to Merewether beach there is another coffee bar close to the ocean

### **Sport activities**

Try the gym (it's called The Forum) with a Free Membership for 1 week.

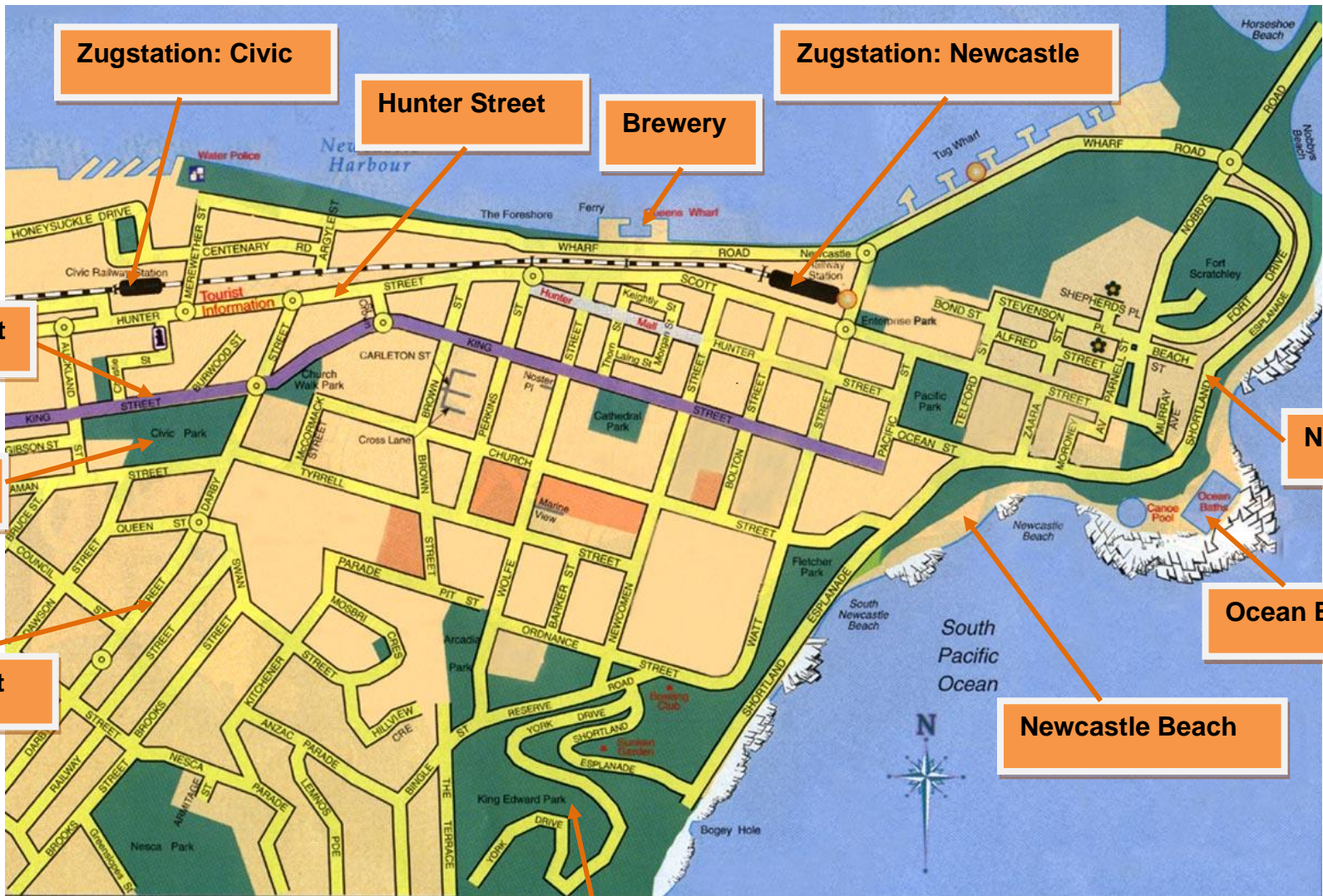
